



IT Systems Analyst/Tester

- Take ownership for delivering accurate estimates of time and resource required for assigned test phases, including dependencies, risks and assumptions made.
- Communicate progress against plan with project managers and supervisor for any work packages assigned.
- Assist the business in user acceptance testing.
- Take ownership for sign off of testing phases to confirm exit criteria has been achieved or escalate any identified risks.
- Monitor and resolve system users issues directly or by referring to other IT functions
- Develop and maintain relevant work package/project/third party relationships to ensure quality and required standards are met and maintained.

In addition, the successful candidate will require previous experience of working as part of Test / Development Team coupled with a proven understanding and extensive hands on use of test methodologies and proven experience with test script preparation & execution.
