**CHANGES TO THE FIDELITY FUNDS – AUSTRALIA FUND AND IMPACT ON YOUR RL360 PLAN

Fidelity Funds has announced a number of changes to its Fidelity Funds - Australia Fund (the "Fund") that will take effect on 26 October 2021 (the "effective date").

Your plan invests in the fund so we wanted to make you aware of the changes and explain your options for switching to a different fund if you prefer.

Summary of the changes

From the effective date the name of the Fund will change from Fidelity Funds – Australia Fund to Fidelity Funds – Australian Diversified Equity Fund.

Also the investment policy and objective of the Fund will be amended in order to broaden the investment scope of the Fund. A comparison of these changes can be found overleaf.

Your options

If you are happy with these changes, you don't need to do anything. However, if you would prefer to switch to a different fund available to your plan, it's free of charge, and very easy to do. You may want to discuss the options with your financial adviser before deciding.
